Supervision Ratios

Beavers (6-8yrs): 1:1 Cubs (8-10yrs): 1:2

Scouts/Explorers (10yrs +): minimum 2 leaders.

We will provide a suitably qualified range offer to oversee the activity. Groups must provide sufficient adults to make up the ratio. These leaders/young leaders do not need to be qualified, as they will be briefed and supervised by the Range Officer.

Own Instructor / Own Equipment

We will require a copy of the instructor's qualifications before they will be allowed to run a session on our range. This should be sent to our bookings office, at least 28 days before your booking.

We only allow air rifles (max bore 0.177"/4.5mm) to be used on our range. If you wish to bring your own equipment for a shooting session, please request an "Own Equipment Application Form" from our bookings office. This must be completed and returned to us for approval, no later than 28 days before your booking.

Additional Needs

We will try as far as possible to make the activity as inclusive as possible. Please make us aware as early as possible (via the bookings office) of any additional needs in your group, so that we may organise additional equipment or instruments as necessary.

Permission to Shoot

All participants under 18 years must provide a "Permission to Shoot" form signed by their parent or legal guardian. This is a POR and Drum Hill requirement. This form CANNOT be signed by a leader. Blank forms can be obtained from the Drum Hill website. NO SIGNED FORM = NO SHOOTING.

Adults do not need to complete a form but must read and acknowledge their legal responsibility under the Firearms Act 1968 which is detailed on the "Permission to Shoot" Form.
